FINANCE

St. Mary's Church relies on the contribution of its congregation to meet its commitments in the work of ministry for those in need and for spreading God's Kingdom both at home and abroad.

If you would like to make a regular commitment, it can be done in one of three ways:

- 1. Through the envelope scheme. A regular sum of money is put in an envelope each week throughout the year and offered with the plate collection at Church.
- 2.By making a Gift Aid. This is the best way of giving as it enables the Church to recover the tax paid on gifts. A Gift Aid is made on an open-end basis. Should circumstances change, the agreement can be cancelled without loss to the giver or the Church of payments already made.
- 3. An offering in the open plate at any of the services.


